Litter Overall:

The Loala Litter overall is confident and self-assured. They are appropriately social with other dogs, with one another, and with cats. They show a little stress in new situations and circumstances that would typically be considered stressful. They show no stress with new people. They react appropriately to new sights and sounds being curious and investigative and recovering quickly if they startle. They all have good focus, memory, and problem-solving abilities particularly for their age. They have good motivations for interaction, food, and toys but in varying levels between puppies. The puppies are appropriately social in their interactions with people rarely using their mouths and rarely being vocal. They are very tolerant and accepting of handling and restraint. They genuinely enjoy interaction with people. They have no red flags and show no possessiveness. Overall this litter is very consistent from puppy to puppy. Variances between puppies are listed below.

Individual Notes:

Loala Blue Dot needs a minute to adjust in new situations, but once he adjusts, he has moderate energy. He is playful and curious. He is motivated by food and interaction. He is interested in toys. He is very personable and affectionate and very eager and gentle with handling. He is content to explore and play on his own.
